Work environment

- Leaders, key-staff and work environmental representatives meet 4 times a year to discuss measures in relation to patients showing agitated behavior concerning work environment
- Plan for assistance for staff members in acute situations
- Registration of the staff members closest relatives
- Possibility of supervision, defusing and debriefing
- Registration of situations where staff members have been offended or abused.

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
