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Difficulties in swallowing and eating following acquired brain injury – from a professional and a patient perspective

The main purpose of this thesis is to explore and evaluate the difficulties in swallowing and eating following acquired brain injury during an inpatient rehabilitation programme, from a professional and a patient perspective.

The study consists in two studies. Study 1 is a randomised controlled study and study 2 is a qualitative case-study with six cases included in study 1.
